# WHY THE THRIVE COMMUNITY MATTERS

#### **HUNGER IS A FACT**

BANGLADESH has the highest rate of underweight children in South Asia. Over **SIX MILLION** Bangladeshi CHILDREN suffer from HUNGER.

In Bangladesh, nearly 75% of **children's diets** do not meet dietary standards. High rates of **micronutrient deficiencies** that lead to **delayed brain and muscle development.**




